CULTURE VULTURE - 2 Days PHOTOGRAPHY on location with Professional Photographer Debbi Clark
Teaching the art of photography using SLR Olympus EPL-10 cameras. Artists will enjoy day trips to the city which includes a visit to The National Portrait Gallery with a private tour and talk from their curator and a photography session. There is a trip to the Tate Modern with Artist Nina Mae Fowler who has contributed her time to talk to our young people on this project. ANALOGUE PHOTOGRAPHY COURSE

Supporting young people in Education for studies in GCSE, Further Education and A Level with PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHER: DEBBI CLARK & PAUL ROMANS. This course is an introduction to the Art of Photography supported and mentored by professional photographer Debbi Clark and guest documentary photographer Paul Romans. This is an analogue photography course shooting on both 35mm & 120mm medium format film. Students will be given access to a professional studio set and equipment. This is an incredible opportunity to learn the art of developing and printing photographic images at London DARKROOM guided by professional Philip Grey learning how to create the perfect B/W print. Students will also be encouraged to develop their technical media skills with training using the editing IT platform 'Lightroom Classic' in our Media Studio.
