Participants will explore essential techniques such as composition, lighting, and storytelling through the lens, all while visiting the creativity of life in Camden – with a day out at Camden Market, Hampstead Heath & local areas using professional SLR Olympus cameras and learning edit techniques in Lightroom. Students will develop their unique artistic voice and gain confidence in their photography skills. All participants will be given a USB stick to save their final images to take home and have the opportunity to choose their favourite photograph for the HvH ARTS McCrory Award exhibition this year
